Pastor Kai Yuen on Cantonese Congregation Ministry

Since I joined CBC staff in Sept. 2016, we've come to learn that all brothers and sisters of the Cantonese congregation are very supportive and hardworking; I never have to ask twice for help. Currently, we have Sunday attendance of about 100 people in the worship service and 70 people in the Sunday school classes. We have 7 small groups or fellowship groups which meet mostly once a month; several of them do meet twice a month either at church or in members' homes.

- Joint Quarterly Fellowship to foster fellowship between the smaller communities and those who are not yet a part of any community. First Joint Fellowship for 2017 happened on Jan. 28th, along with the mandarin congregation. With 150 attendance, everyone came hungry and left happy.
