



Genesis 2:1-3 (ESV)

1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. 2 And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. 3 So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.

Notes

Scriptural Questions:

- In the narrative, what happens before and after God rests? What is the author trying to communicate to his audience?
- What is the purpose of God "blessing" the seventh day? And why is it "holy"?
- Read Hebrews 3:18-4:11. How does the author of Hebrews understand the grand story of "rest" in light of Genesis 2?
- How does the goodness of Jesus play into the idea of sabbath rest?

Personal Questions

- In a given week, do you feel more rested? Busy? Frantic? Balanced? Why?
- How do you and your family think through sabbath on a weekly, monthly, and yearly routine?
- If you find resting difficult, what might be some underlying issues that cause this?
- How should the gospel inform your daily and weekly rhythms? How should the gospel inform CBC?

He chose boldness over retreat. He chose Jesus over the threats of man. He chose consistency over compromise. He chose death over surrender. He chose martyrdom over passivity.

Life isn't easy and it never was intended to be so. Even Adam & Eve were supposed to "tend the garden!" Let us learn from Stephen and not fear the challenges that come our way but remain strong as a Christian Family as we "choose Christ and His strength" to face tomorrow and tomorrow's tomorrow!
