Reflection Questions:

- Where else in Scripture is human anger mentioned? What does the Bible have to say about it for us today?
- How might understanding the end of vs. 22 affects how we treat one another?
- Are there unresolved conflicts with "a brother/sister" that you need to act on today?
- The Gospel reminds us that Christ came to save us from sin and death and in return, offer life and hope and joy. Human anger is born from a corrupt sense of judgment and authority. How might the people of God imagine a better way of Gospel-living, in light of this passage?
