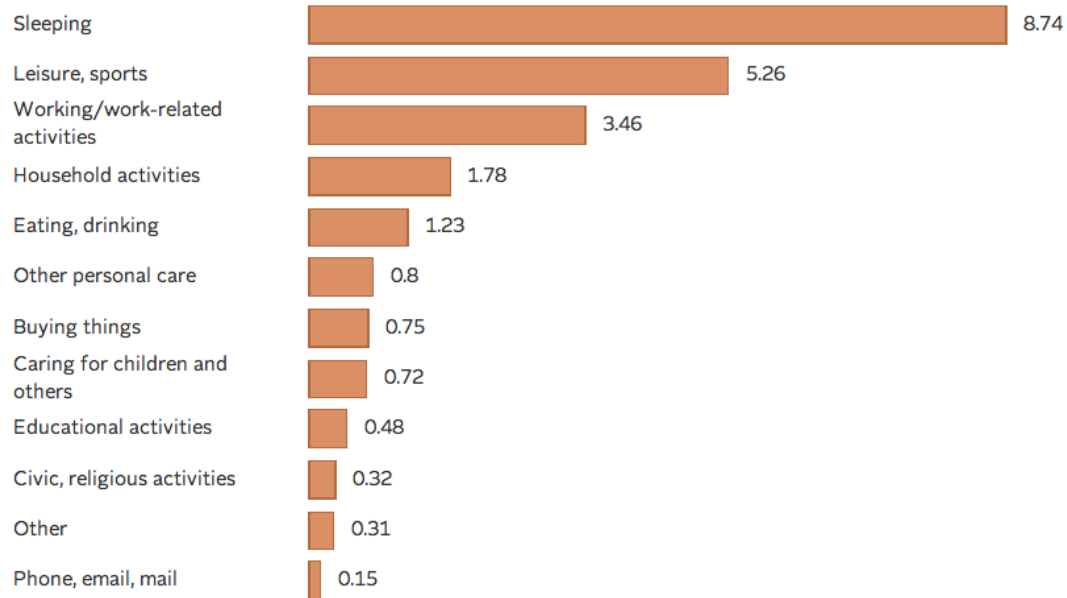

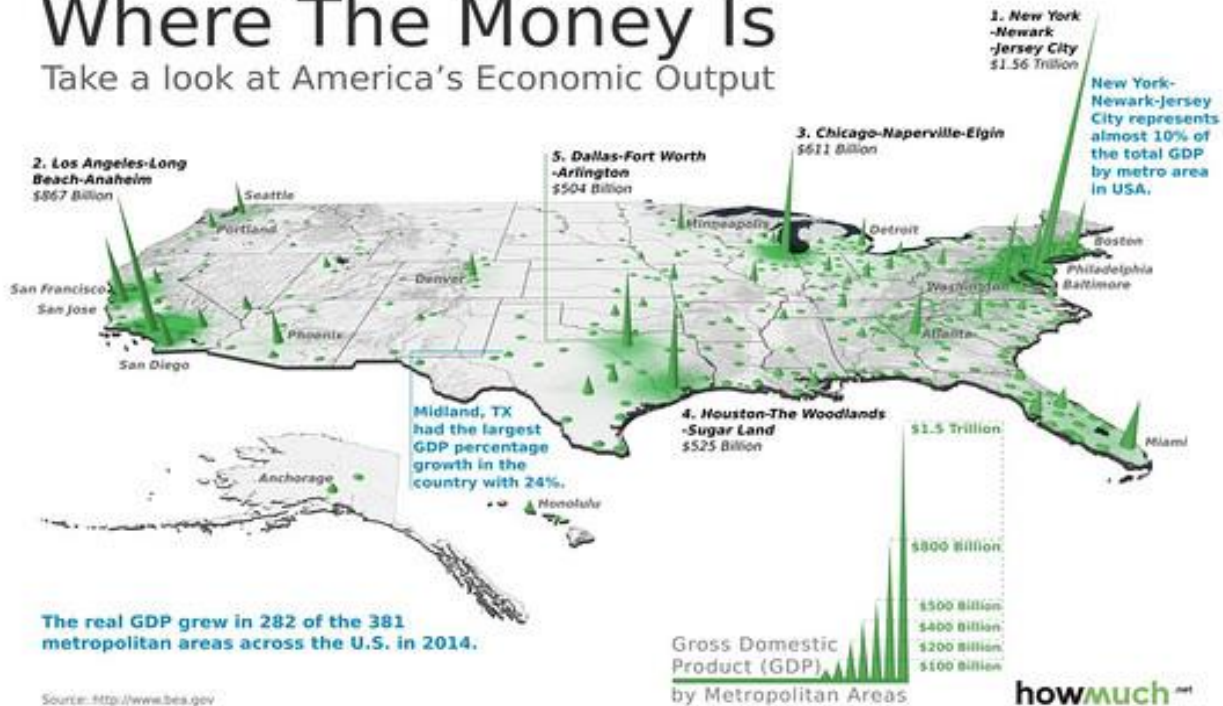

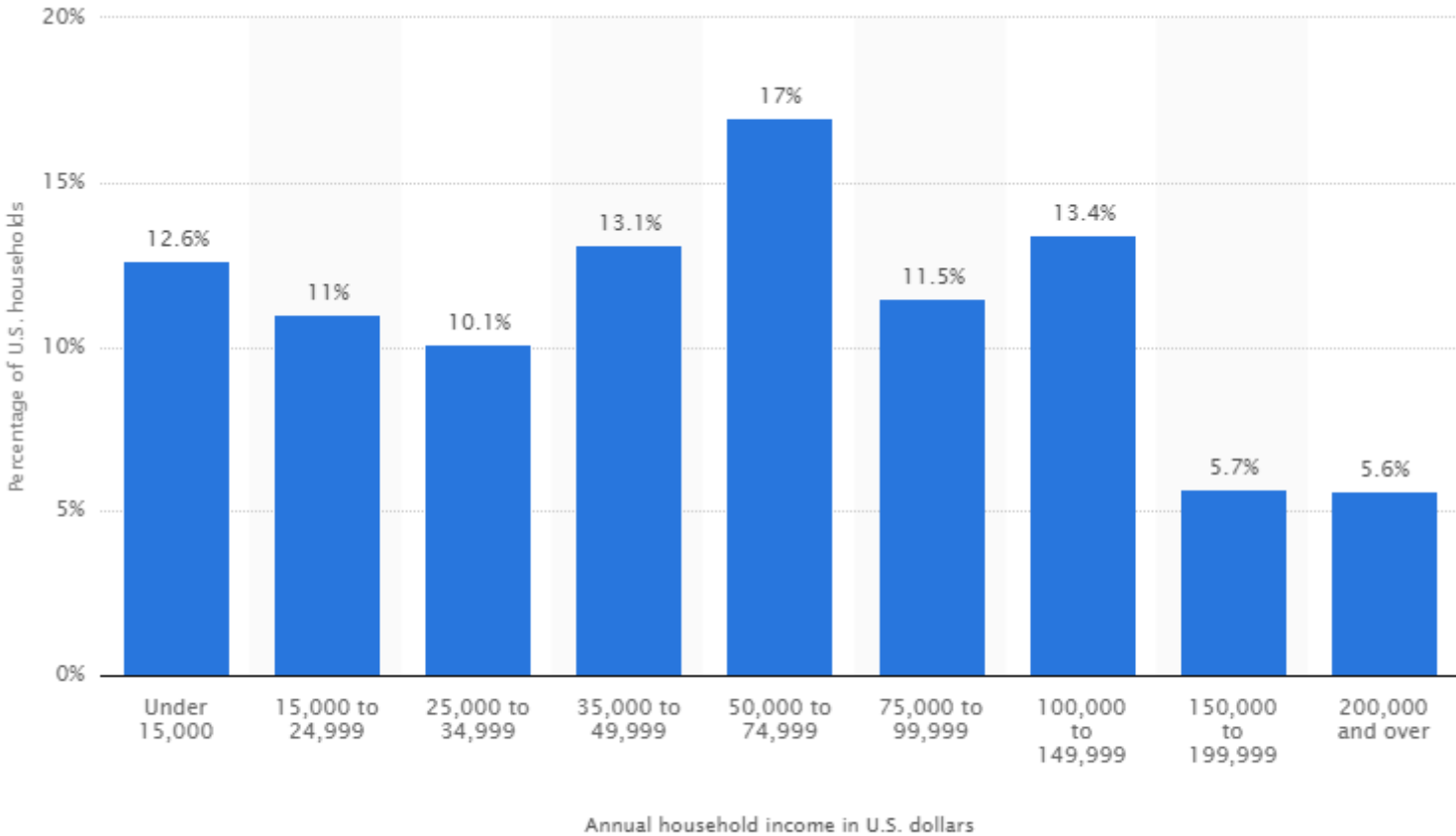

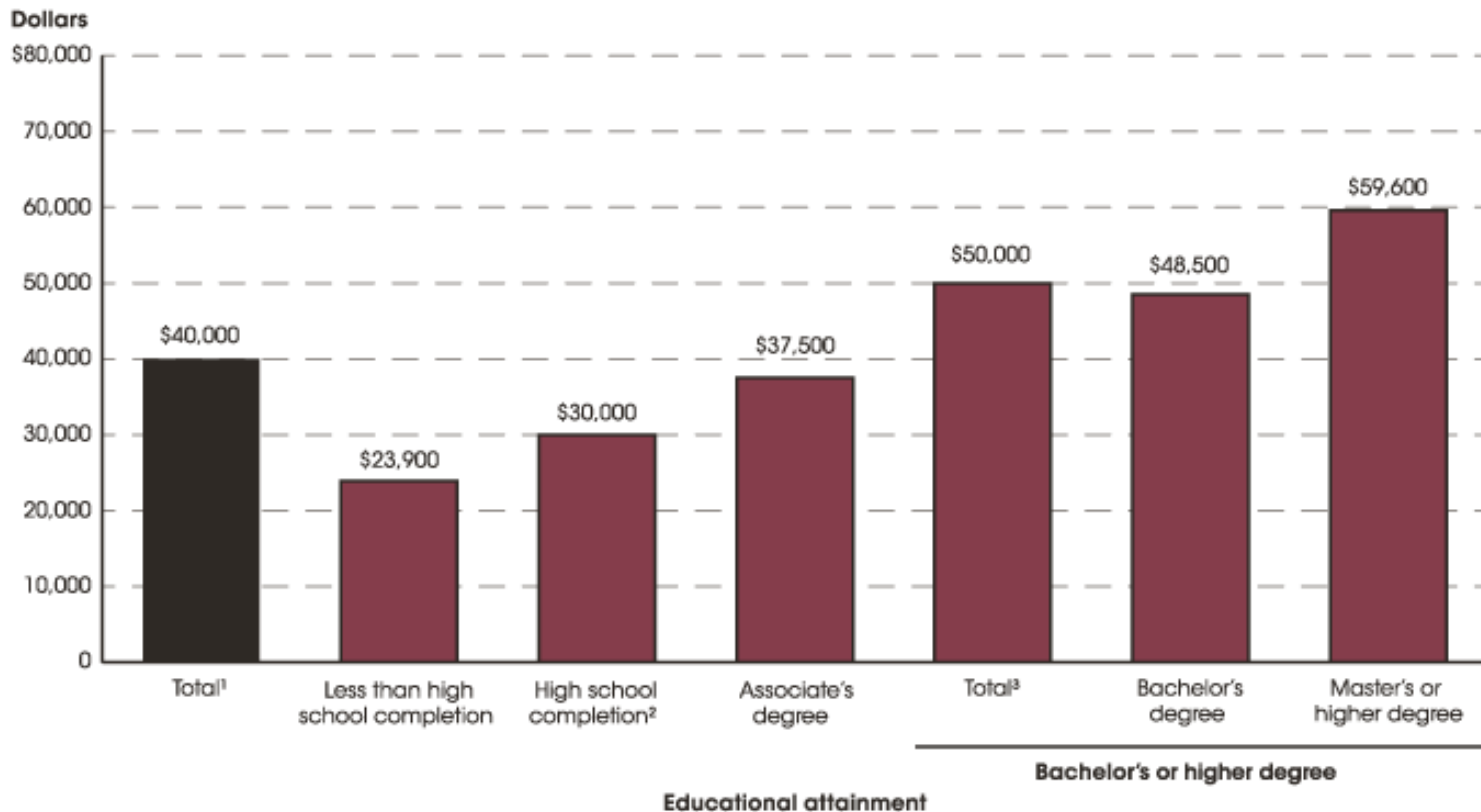

Median annual earnings of full-time year-round workers ages 25-34, by educational attainment: 2013



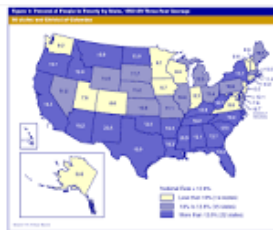

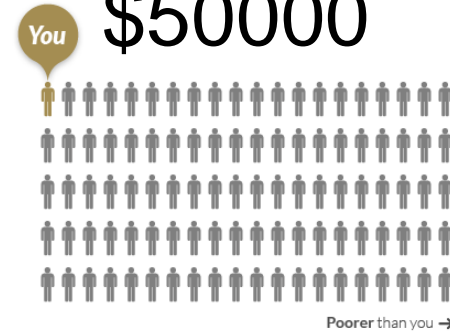

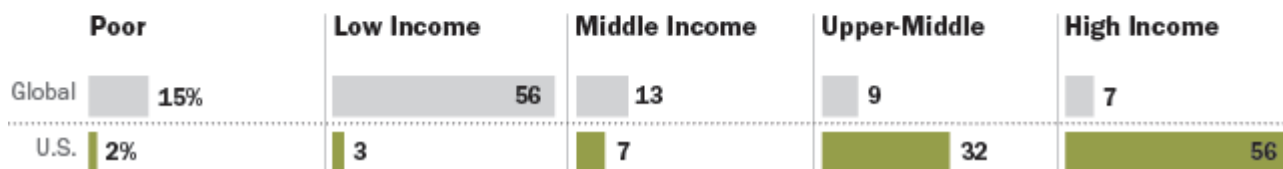

What Would Happen if the Church Tithed?
