


Follow Me – Take Up the Cross






John 6:26-65 (NASB)

- 63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh provides no benefit; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are life.
- 64 But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray Him.
- 65 And He was saying, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted him from the Father."

66 As a result of this many of His disciples left, and would no longer walk with Him

Jesus – Bread of Life Message

Discipleship Question

18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven."

20 Then He gave the disciples strict orders that they were to tell no one that He was the Christ.

Introduces the coming church age

- 21 From that time Jesus began to point out to His disciples that it was necessary for Him to go to Jerusalem and to suffer many things from the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and to be killed, and to be raised up on the third day.
- 22 And yet Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "God forbid it, Lord! This shall never happen to You!"
- 23 But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on God's purposes, but men's."

Ministry Leadership Mentality

Jesus' Ministry Plan - Predicts His Death – 1 of 3x

Matthew 16:24-27 (NASB)

- 24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me.
- 25 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.
- 26 For what good will it do a person if he gains the whole world, but forfeits his soul? Or what will a person give in exchange for his soul?
- 27 For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and will then repay every person according to his deeds.


A Follower's Commitment

Matthew 17:1-3 (NASB)

- Six days later, Jesus *took with Him Peter and James, and his brother John, and *led them up on a high mountain by themselves.
- 2 And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light.
- 3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.

Timeline of Events

- Conversation took place around the time of "Bread of Life" message where many followers deserted Jesus (John 6:59-65)
- Conversation transitions Jesus' ministry from public to private (Matt 16:21)
- Conversation prepares Jesus' disciples for the church age (Matt 16:18-20)
- Conversation took place six days before Jesus' Transfiguration (Matt 17:1)



Key Themes

- "Bread of Life" message where many followers deserted Jesus (John 6:59-65)
- Identity Question Who do people say I am? (Matt 16:13)
- Discipleship Question Who do YOU say I am? (Matt 16:15)
- Commitment Question Whoever wants to save his life will lose it... (Matt 16:25)
- Church Age On this Rock... (Matt 16:18)
- Ministry Leadership Mind of Christ vs of men (Matt 16:23)
- Christ's Ministry Plan Predicts His Death 3x (Matt 16:21)
- Deny Self / Take Up the Cross (Matt 16:24)

John 6:1-4 (NASB)

- 1 After these things Jesus went away to the other side of the Sea of Galilee (or Tiberias).
- 2 A large crowd was following Him, because they were watching the signs which He was performing on those who were sick.
- 3 But Jesus went up on the mountain, and there He sat with His disciples.

Now the Passover, the feast of the Jews, was near.


Just Before Feeding 5000

John 7:1-4 (NASB)

- 1 After these things Jesus was walking in Galilee, for He was unwilling to walk in Judea because the Jews were seeking to kill Him.
- Now the feast of the Jews, the Feast of Booths, was near.
- 3 So His brothers said to Him, "Move on from here and go into Judea, so that Your disciples also may see Your works which You are doing.
- 4 For no one does anything in secret when he himself is striving to be known publicly. If You are doing these things, show Yourself to the world."

Discipleship Training for the Twelve

- Sends out the Twelve (Matt 10:1-11:1)
 - John the Baptist is beheaded
- Twelve Returns, Began Teaching about the Kingdom using Parables (Matt 13)
- Passover is near (John 6:4)
 - Feeds 5000 (Matt 14:13-21; John 6:1-15)
 - Walks on Water (Matt 14:22-36; John 6:16-24)
 - Bread of Life (John 6:25-65)
 - Syro-Phoenician Woman (Matt 15:21-28)
 - Feeds 4000 (Matt 15:29-39)
 - Follow Me (Matt 16:24 / Jn 6:66-71)

Malachi (Mal 4:5-6) prophesied that Elijah would return before the great and dreadful day of the LORD (Mal 4:5-6)

Looking for an "Elijah" type character

Theological Principle (Christian Civic Responsibility Edition):

Unrelenting emphasis on personal preferences on character expected from Scripture, (I will sit this one out...)

Elijah

John the Baptist

One of the Prophets

Based on a rumor perpetuated by King Herod at that time. King Herod evidently did not know that Jesus and John the Baptist were seen together.

Defers to the views of the current authority

Theological Principle (Christian Civic Responsibility Edition):

Unwise trust on sources / authorities regarding what is factual (low information voter...)

Elijah

- John the Baptist
- One of the Prophets
- General perception that Jesus is merely another prophet like Jeremiah.
 - Messenger vs Message (Views Religion as a practice)
 - Lacks understanding about Christ

Theological Principle (Christian Civic Responsibility Edition):

Unwavering loyalty to specific ideology / issue / group; ("white dudes for")

Right Response to Jesus' Identity

Identity = Value

Theological Principle (Christian Civic Responsibility Edition):

- What are your (our) values?
 - Avoid Elijah Symptom
 - Avoid John the Baptist Symptom
 - Avoid One of the Prophets Symptom

"Follow Me" Principle I –

Following Jesus – in ministry leadership – requires us to develop our own understanding and confession about Jesus, and NOT rely on public opinions

Theological Principle (Christian Civic Responsibility Edition):

Do your own Research / Understand the issues Value Alignment; Not Value Conformity / Uniformity
